Project - “Class in the nature, nature in the classroom“
Report on the Comenius Partnership Project Meeting
February 12th to 16th - Základná škola Humenné, Slovakia



The fifth meeting of the project took place at Základná škola Kudlovska Humenné in Slovakia.

The participants were:

- Bulgaria – 3 teachers, 2 students
- Italy – 2 teachers, 6 students
- Latvia – 3 teachers, 4 students
- Portugal – 4 teachers, 3 students
- Spain – 4 teachers, 6 students
- Turkey – 2 teachers, 2 students

12th February – arriving day, teams arrived in Budapest, Turkish team arrived to Košice, they were taken to Humenné by bus.

Students were hosted in families, teachers were staying in the hotel.

13th February – Project opening day at Základná škola Kudlovska, introduction of the management of the school.

After the official opening teams visited some parts of the school- because of the reconstruction it wasn't possible to see every part of the school.

After visiting the school and short break, all teams went to see open air museum- the museum with typical wooden architecture.

The afternoon started by visiting Humenné manor house. The visitors could see historical part of the manor house, natural science exhibition, art exhibition and sacral exhibition.



After visiting the manor house, we moved to the Town Hall, where the principal welcomed all the teams. Then every partner introduced his/her own school, town and teams introduced themselves.

In the evening students had dinners at their families and they met again after dinner at the bowling centre. Teachers had dinner in the restaurant.

14th February – High Tatras

The guests visited High Tatras. In the morning they visited Belianska cave and in the afternoon they went to see one of the most popular touristic place and the lake Štrbské pleso. They came back to Humenné late in the evening

15th February- Horse Farm

In the morning we took guests to the Horse farm, there were prepared some kinds of activities, but because of the bad weather condition, only some of them could be realized- riding a horse and “barbecue”. After lunch at school canteen children went to the host families or they stayed at school with students to get ready for the school ball.



In the same time there was coordinator’s meeting held. There were discussed the project progress, planning of the next meetings, ideas for the next meeting.

The local activities done since September 2011 till January 2012

Bulgaria: World day of the tree- planting trees in the school yard, Day of the peace, Cleaning the river and school yard, Discussion- how to protect the nature, Night of the Bats- European day of the bats, Science lesson in the nature, Visiting the cave Lednica, Visiting Environmental centre of nature

Italy: web site, Herbarium

Latvia: Nature in Art, Herbarium, Self made games – Saving of energy, Guessing game (about animals), Nature week, Helping animals, Hours in nature, Innovation bus, Eco- school activities, Project notice board

Portugal: Collection of the typical autumn products- exhibition, Decoration walls by waste material, paintings with recycled materials, making Biological farm- planting plants there, Herbarium

Spain: Slide show, Visiting Observatory, Herbarium

Slovakia: Collecting the paper, The Day of healthy food, The pumpkin show, Making “lokše” by children- typical Slovak food, Swimming course, Gingerbread decoration- pre Christmas activity, Ice skating course, Competition- Bins for the waste materials, Herbarium

Turkey: Planting vegetable, Cleaning the school backyard, Cleanest classroom competition, Cleaning beaches, Prevention of animals, Taking care about the school dog- found in the street.

After talking about local activities the coordinator informed us, that she is going to represent our project to Brussels on 3rd and 4th May. There will be an exhibition. Our task is to bring herbarium specimens for the next meeting- Turkey and send to Tullio (Italy) presentation we want to be shown in Brussels.
