Report on the *Comenius* Partnership Project Meeting
October 23rd to 27th 2011

Piero Camandrei School, Rome, Italy

The participants were:

- Bulgaria – 6 teachers
- Spain -2 teachers and 6 students
- Portugal – 2 teachers and 4 students
- Latvia – 3 teachers and 3 students
- Slovakia – 3 teachers and 5 students
- Turkey – 3 teachers and 2 students

All the partners (teachers and students) arrived in Rome on the **23rd October** . The teachers were picked up at the airport by Italian teachers and taken to their hotels, students by the host families.

On the **24th October** at 9.30 the meeting started at Piero Camandrei School. The Italian Headmaster welcomed everybody then every partner introduced her/his own school and country/town. The Italian teachers and students showed their school and the herbarium created at the beginning of the Project. At 12.00 all the coordinators met to discuss new ideas for the next mobility. After lunch held at school, the Comenius group went sightseeing Rome on the open bus and then did a guided visit of the Colosseum.



On the **25th October** at 9.30 the meeting started. It was organized an open day on the theme “Let’s protect nature”.

An interesting video made by Italian students was showed; it dealt with floods which have afflicted Italy until now.

Then Local Authorities took part in the debate about “waste and recycling”.

Every partner showed a power point presentation about the habits of their students to protect the environment.

After lunch held at school, the Comenius group went to visit Palazzo Corsini, an ancient building next to the Botanical Garden which, unfortunately, was closed because a terrible thunderstorm had caused some damages one week before.



On the **26th October** the whole day was dedicated to the visit of Rome. In the morning there was the visit of Borghese Gallery, in the afternoon the visit of the Senate .



On the **27th October** all teachers and their students left.
